Presets breakdown

Nuance Audio comes with **4 designated presets to help you find the best setup for your listening preferences.**

Presets are preconfigured amplification settings designed to enhance your listening experience with your Nuance Audio Glasses. Each preset addresses different amplification needs by adjusting various frequencies.

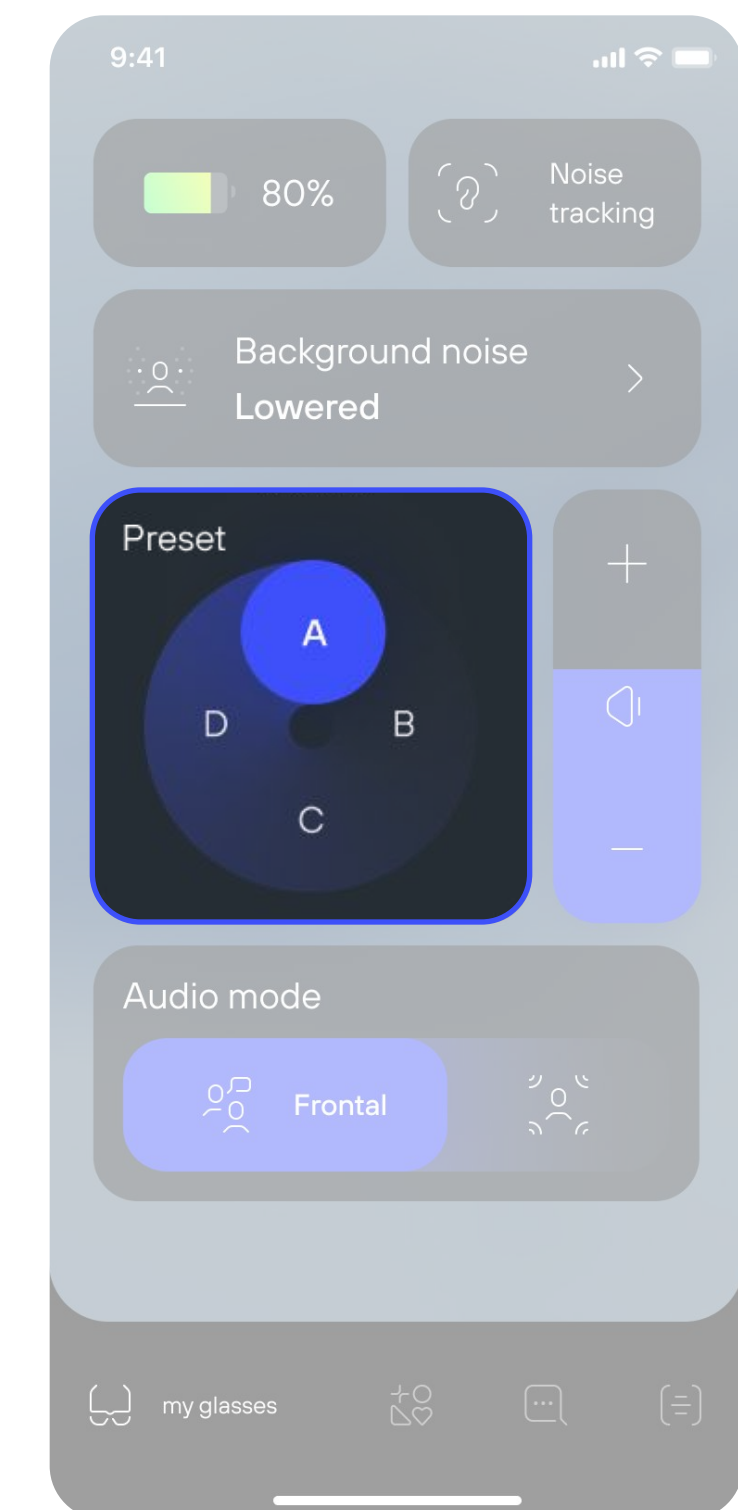
Get started by first calibrating your glasses in a silent room.

Then, go to your Nuance Audio App homepage and toggle between all 4 presets – A, B, C, and D.

Keep in mind that you can always change your settings and adapt them to your daily life, depending on your specific needs and environment.

Preset A

For someone who generally follows conversations well in everyday situations but may appreciate a small amount of amplification to better catch certain words or details, especially when the environment is less than ideal.





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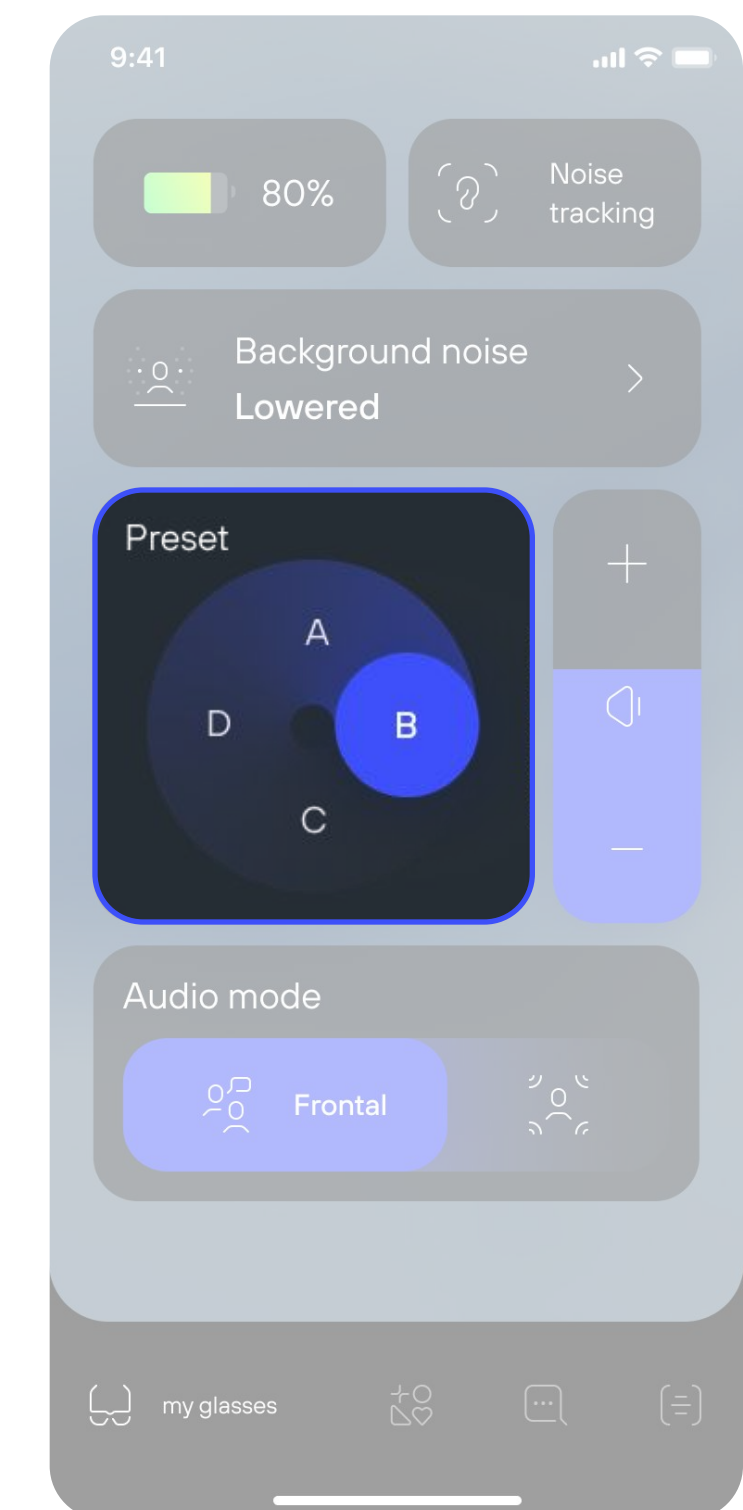
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Preset B

For someone who follows conversations comfortably in quiet, one-on-one situations but may find it harder to catch certain parts of speech in noisier environments or when several people are talking, and who may benefit from a light level of amplification in those moments.





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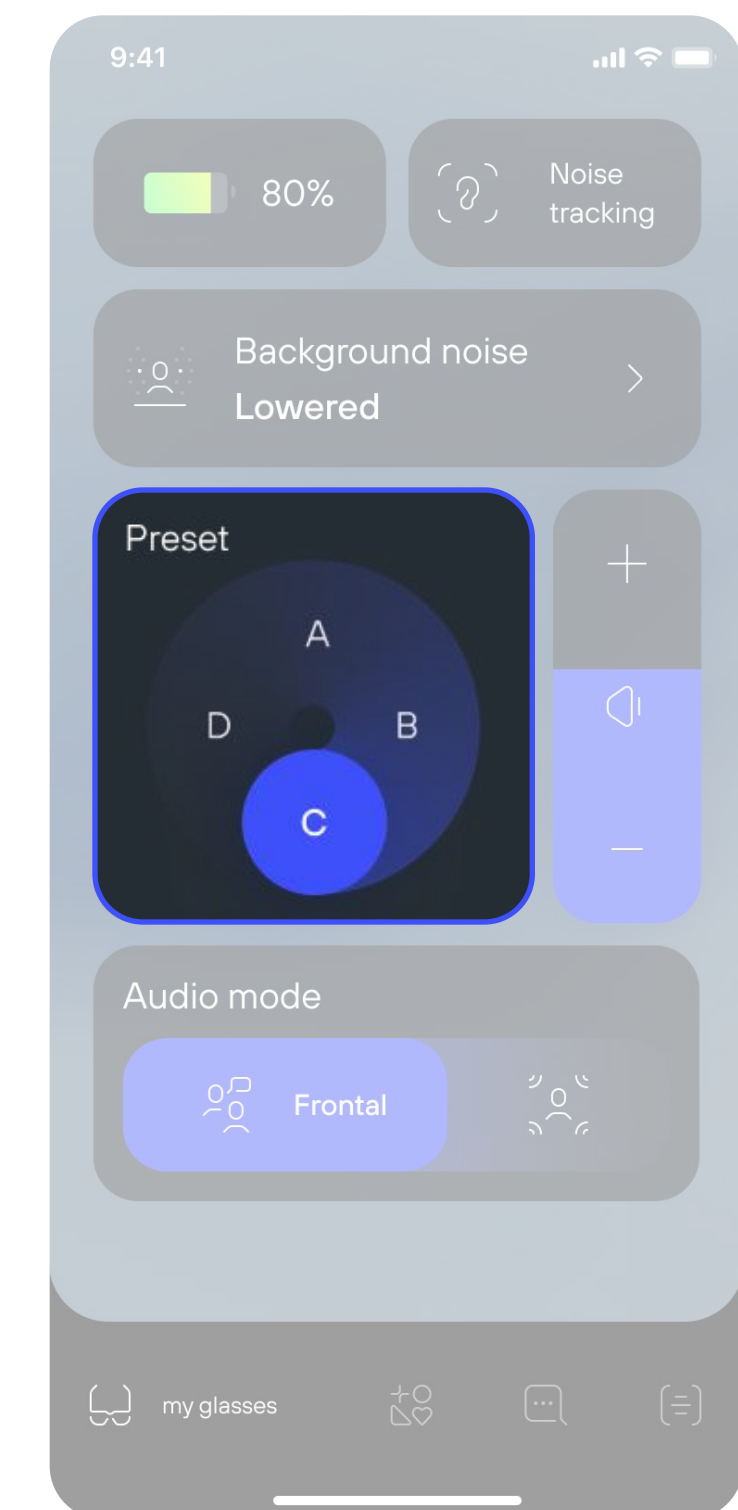
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Preset C

For someone who follows conversations but may miss occasional words or details in busy or fast-moving situations and would appreciate added support to stay connected in those moments.





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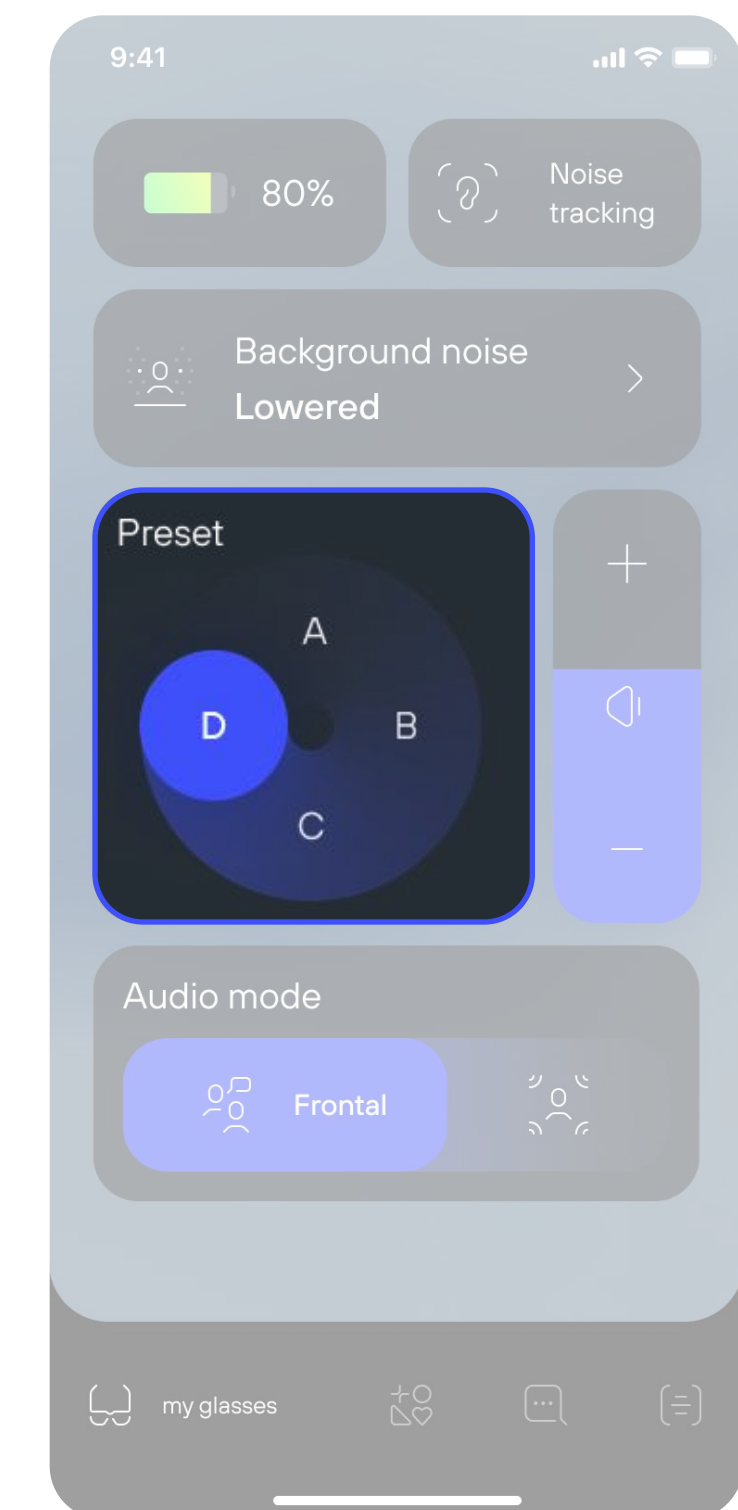
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Preset D

For someone who may find conversations less clear even in quieter settings and could benefit from gentle amplification to help make spoken details easier to follow.





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
